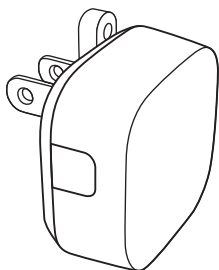

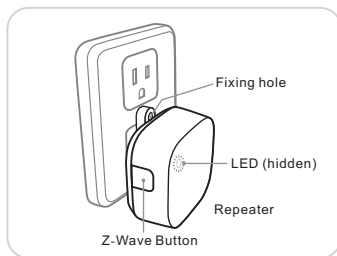


1 Aeotec Repeater

Your Aeotec Repeater has been designed to improve the reliability and performance of your Z-Wave network. It'll receive weak Z-Wave communications, and then rebroadcast them at full strength.

2 Familiarise yourself with your Repeater

Your Repeater is installed by plugging it into a power outlet.

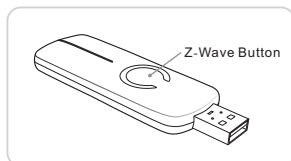


3 Quick Start

Getting your Aeotec Repeater up and running is as simple as plugging it into a wall outlet and linking it to your existing Z-Wave network. The following instructions tell you how to link your Repeater to your Z-Wave network using Aeotec's Z-Stick or Minimote controllers. If you are using other products as your main Z-Wave controller, please refer to the part of their respective manuals that tells you how to add new devices to your network.

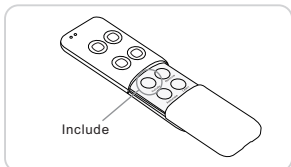
• If you're using a Z-Stick:

1. Decide on where you want your Repeater to be placed, plug it in, and turn the power outlet on. Its LED will begin to blink.
2. If your Z-Stick is plugged into a USB port, unplug it.
3. Take your Z-Stick to your Repeater.
4. Press the Z-Wave Button on your Z-Stick.
5. Press the Z-Wave Button on your Repeater.
6. If your Repeater has been successfully linked to your network, its LED will no longer blink. If the linking was unsuccessful, the LED will continue to blink.
7. Press the Z-Wave Button on the Z-Stick to exit inclusion mode.



• If you're using a Minimote:

1. Decide on where you want your Repeater to be placed, plug it in, and turn the power outlet on. Its LED will begin to blink.
2. Take your Minimote to your Repeater.
3. Press the "Include" button on your Minimote.
4. Press the Z-Wave Button on your Repeater.
5. If your Repeater has been successfully linked to your network, its LED will no longer blink. If the linking was unsuccessful, the LED will continue to blink.
6. Press any button on your Minimote to exit inclusion mode.



Now your Repeater is up and running.

4 Advanced Functions

• Removing your Repeater from a Z-Wave network

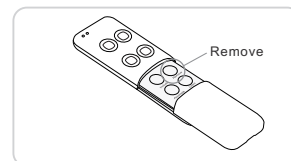
Your Repeater can be removed from your Z-Wave network at any time. You'll need to use your Z-Wave network's main controller to do this. The following instructions tell you how to do this using Aeotec's Z-Stick and Minimote controllers. If you are using other products as your main Z-Wave controller, please refer to the part of their respective manuals that tells you how to remove devices from your network.

• If you're using a Z-Stick:

1. If your Z-Stick is plugged into a USB port, unplug it.
2. Take your Z-Stick to your Repeater.
3. Press the Z-Wave Button on your Z-Stick.
4. Press the Z-Wave Button on your Repeater.
5. If your Repeater has been successfully removed from your network, its LED will blink. If the removal was unsuccessful, its LED will not blink.
6. Press the Z-Wave Button on the Z-Stick to exit inclusion mode.

• If you're using a Minimote:

1. Take your Minimote to your Repeater.
2. Press the "Remove" button on your Minimote.
3. Press the Z-Wave Button on your Repeater.
4. If your Repeater has been successfully removed from your network, its LED will blink. If the removal was unsuccessful, its LED will not blink.
5. Press any button on your Minimote to exit inclusion mode.

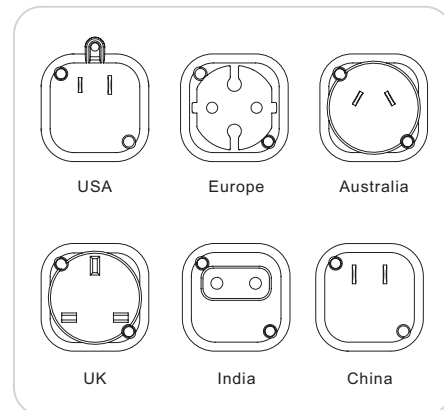

6 Warranty

Aeon Labs warrants to the original purchaser of Products that for the Warranty Period (as defined below), the Products will be free from material defects in materials and workmanship. The "Warranty Period" begins on the date the Products is delivered and continues for 12 months.

Any repairs under this warranty must be conducted by an authorized Aeon Labs service representative and under Aeon Labs' RMA policy. Any repairs conducted by unauthorized persons shall void this warranty.

Excluded from the warranty are problems due to accidents, acts of God, civil or military authority, civil disturbance, war, strikes, fires, other catastrophes, misuse, misapplication, storage damage, negligence, electrical power problems, or modification to the Products or its components.
